WE THE PEOPLE URGE THE AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT TO ENACT #MagnitskyActNow

The onslaught of Myanmar’s military coup, oppression of Thai pro-democracy activists, Hong Kong’s ever-escalating political prosecutions, the Uyghur genocide, the cultural genocide in Tibet, CCP’s persecution of Falun Gong practitioners, and innumerable cases of human rights violations and crimes against humanity across the globe, are all evidence that an Australian Magnitsky-style Act is needed now more than ever.

We call upon the Australian Parliament to enact the Magnitsky-style legislation without delay, because:

- ***It will significantly strengthen Australian and broaden international efforts to deter gross human rights violations and significant corruptions worldwide;***
- ***It will ensure targeted sanctions against human rights violators, their family and organisations, as well as other corrupted participants;***
- ***The existing legal avenues and tools are not adequate nor effective in deterring further wrongs and violations; and***
- ***Australia is at risk of becoming the migration destination for human rights violators as the only country not protected by a Magnitsky Act among its allies (UK, US, EU and Canada).***

We strongly believe that the Australia Magnitsky-style Act is crucial in both defending human rights and protecting Australia from becoming violators’ safe haven.
